# **THIS DECLARATION OF TRUST IS MADE**

(‘the first trustees’)

The first trustees hold the sum of £1575.00 on the trusts declared in this deed and they expect that more money or assets will be acquired by them on the same trusts.

## **NOW THIS DEED WITNESSES AS FOLLOWS:**

### **1. Administration**

The charitable trust created by this deed (‘the charity’) shall be administered by the trustees. (In this deed, the expression ‘the trustees’ refers to the individuals who are the trustees of the charity at any given time. It includes the first trustees and their successors. The word ‘trustee’ is used to refer to any one of the trustees.)

### **2. Name**

The charity shall be called LEICESTER COMMUNITY ASSIST working name LCA.

### **3. Objects**

The objects of the charity (‘the objects’) are:

- (1) The prevention or relief of poverty in the UK by providing: grants, items and services to individuals in need and/or charities, or other organisations working to prevent or relieve poverty;
- (2) The promotion of religious harmony for the benefit of the public by educating the public in different religious beliefs including an awareness of their distinctive features and their common ground to promote good relations between persons of different faiths;
- (3) To advance the Islamic religion in the UK for the benefit of the public through the holding of prayer meetings, lectures, public celebration of religious festivals, producing and/or distributing literature on Islam to enlighten others about the Islamic religion;
- (4) To promote any other charitable purpose for the benefit of those in need that the trustees from time to time determine.
